Here, for the first time, under the soaring roof of Benildus Hall, set in a beautiful Australian landscape, visitors were able to admire and appreciate the work of many leading Sydney artists and craftsmen.

Never before in the Hills District has there been such a rich variety of work for inspection and sale. Nearly two thousand people visited the Exhibition, which was officially opened on Friday, 9th July by radio personality Mr John Pearce. O.B.E.

Paintings by established Australian artists from well known city galleries were on view along with those by artists from many suburban art societies. The Argyle Arts Centre provided work by contemporary artists and artisans in many fields.

Pottery, sculpture, hand enamelled copper, hand-crafted copperware, pewter and fashion jewellery were eagerly purchased. Selection of a painting became a combined affair as husbands discussed with their wives the purchase of possibly their first original painting.
