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# Study sequence

## With Parallel Text

- **Visualise** the English text first. It's a preview of the otherwise unfamiliar words used in the notes. It will facilitate translating the Italian text. **Visualisation** is the most important principle in Professional Memory Training. It means **visualising** where the story takes place (the setting) and the actors involved. It also means **hearing** in your mind what they **say**.
- Read the words aloud, making sure that the stress is initially on the **green** syllable. For the details and other questions, refer to my "**Italian Grammar in a Nutshell**".
- **Parallel Text**: first mentally translate the Italian text, and then the English one.

### How to improve your ability to learn a foreign language.

1. Do the Professional Memory Training exercises listed in my "Creative Writing".
2. While doing automatic chores like doing the dishes, cleaning and driving, mentally rehearse the Italian

past- and present lessons. Doing this before falling asleep works wonders because you are relaxed. It's more beneficial than studying too long. Memorising the English texts pays off!

## Verbs

As in Latin, each person has its own form, so there are groups of 6 for each tense (past, present, future...). Personal pronouns are usually left out unless to emphasise: io, tu (you for friends and family), lui, lei, noi, voi, loro. You-the polite form-uses the verb form of she.
